

# Driver Education - 2012

## Things to Know

- Indiana BMV is closed on Mondays.
- A **Board of Health certified** birth certificate is required at the Indiana BMV.
- All driving is done with two students per car – students and instructors are never alone in auto. All instructors have gone through a national security check.
- Students must have both paper and plastic permits with them every time they attend Driver Education.
- Students must wear an enclosed shoe (no sandals) and no stacked platform shoes. FWCS dress code must be followed, and that includes appropriate school clothing.
- Students must complete a log of 50 hours (40 daytime and 10 night time) before receiving their probationary license. We will provide the student with that log for the parent and student to complete together.
- The required Indiana State Drive Test is available through our program if the student meets the state requirements. Fee for that drive test is \$25 – Drive test is free at the BMV.
- If a student fails to arrive for scheduled drive time there is a \$25 per hour fee for make up lesson.
- Once scheduled for class a fee of \$25 will be due if a student withdraws or moves to a different session. No refunds will be given once classes begin unless proof of family emergency or severe illness is demonstrated.

### Registration Deadlines:

June Session -Friday May 25, 2012

July Session - Friday June 22, 2012

Class preference will be filled in the order the applications are received. Register early to get a first choice.

## Driver Education Cost

Driving only	\$310
Classroom only	\$ 85
<b>Total for both</b>	<b>\$395</b>

**To register, payment may be made for half of the cost of the program, which is \$197.50. The remaining is due when the student begins the first class.**

**If signing up for driving only, the student must produce proof of class completion in another driver education program.**



## Goals

To teach the safe, efficient operation of a motor vehicle and to develop the proper skills and attitudes needed for defensive driving are the primary goals and objectives of our program.

## State Requirements

Indiana State law requires all Driver Education schools to provide 30 hours of classroom instruction and a full 6 hours of driving instruction.

## Facts

FWCS is one of the longest running Driver Ed programs in the state of Indiana, beginning over 55 years ago in 1956. Every instructor is a professional teacher/educator with many years experience in the public school classroom as well as special training in Driver Education. Over 400 years of experienced instruction is represented in our teaching staff!

## Age Requirements

To be eligible for Driver Education in Indiana a student must be 15 years of age by the first day of the program. Upon registering for Driver Education the student will receive paperwork from our program which allows he or she to receive their permit within three weeks of the start of the program. A student must be registered for both components (classroom and driving) to receive this paperwork.

## Attendance

In order to successfully complete the program students must meet Indiana Driver Education attendance requirements. Students must attend all driving classes as well as classroom classes to meet this requirement. If a student has an emergency absence (i.e. death in the family) they are required to make that class up as quickly as possible and within the three week long class session.
