Scholastic Art and Writing – Dick Blick Art Educator Award

Scholastic Art and Writing Awards

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize the Fort Wayne Community Schools students who won regional and national awards for Scholastic Art and Writing.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Scholastic Art and Writing Awards have recognized student achievement in visual arts and creative writing for 90-plus years. This year there were 4,310 entries across the region and 377 Gold Keys were awarded. Gold Key winners went on to the national competition, where three FWCS students received National Silver Medals. Fort Wayne Community Schools had 55 students who won regional gold or silver keys and some students won multiple awards at the regional level. Lily Dukes of Memorial Park Middle School and Martin Mbuguah of South Side High School were American Visions nominees in art. Mbuguah, along with Rayanna Batchelder of Northrop High School and Kaylei Wiechart of Blackhawk Middle School were awarded National Silver Medals.
