OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the School Administration Building on Monday, November 24, 1969, at 7:30 P.M. Vice-President Lawrence P. Wyatt presided with the following members in attendance:

The minutes of the regular meeting held November 10, 1969, were introduced. An error was noted on page three and was corrected as follows: "It was recommended that forty-five hours per quarter be allowed against the retainer fee of \$1500.00 per quarter or \$500.00 per month and that \$35.00 per hour be billed for services in excess of forty-five hours in any quarter for services rendered in connection with real estate matters and other non-litigation matters, and \$40.00 per hour for services rendered in connection with any litigation." A motion was made by Eugene A. Yergens, seconded by W. Lloyd Bridges, that the minutes of the meeting held November 10, 1969, be approved as corrected. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Superintendent Grile reported that President Harmon Frye is making satisfactory progress in his illness, but will be in the Lutheran Hospital for some time. President Frye is in the coronary care unit, and his condition seems encouraging.
