This week you may be expecting to receive mid-term or interim grades for your child.

For many years, we have printed paper copies of student progress at the half-way point of each quarter and sent them home with students. Prior to our adoption of Pinnacle, an online grading system, in 2011, paper interim reports were an important way for schools to communicate student progress. This report serves as a snapshot in time, however, and oftentimes by the time a parent receives the paper copy, the grades are already or soon will be outdated.

For these reasons, we will no longer be printing paper copies of interim grades for all students. Instead, please access your child's account on Pinnacle at any time during the school year to monitor his/her progress. If you need assistance accessing your child's account or their grades, please contact your school. If your student is struggling, we expect your child's teacher(s) will be in direct contact with you. And, if at any time, you have concerns about your child's academic progress, please contact your child's teacher(s).
