Classroom News:

Welcome to 3rd grade! You may notice that some things have changed while others are the same. We will be using the **Rainbow of Responsibility** again this year. Students will be able to move back up when they show they have turned their behavior around and are demonstrating what it is to be **respectful, responsible, and safe**. The color that your child ends his/her day on will be recorded on the calendar on the front of this folder every day. Please look for a note if the Orange or Red box has been marked, as one will come home from the office. New this year – students will be able to earn Cub Cash to spend at the Cub Store. Any adult in the building can ‘pay’ a student for their good behavior and positive actions throughout the day. Students will get to spend their Cub Cast once a month at the Cub Store.

Math:

We will begin working on our first unit in Math – Number Sense. In this unit, students will learn different ways to name numbers (digits, words, models, and expanded form). We will also develop our understanding of place value and rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and 100.

Spanish:

We will begin by reviewing frequently used words and phrases in the classroom and numbers from 0 to 1,000 in Spanish. Students will be writing the numbers in digits and word form. It is very important that students are able to recognize and count beyond 1,000 in order to be successful with our math lessons in Spanish.

Science/Social Studies/Health:

We will begin the year in Science with the kit about Sound. We will begin Social Studies and Health after completing the first Science unit.

Homework:

Math homework will go home on every **Monday and Wednesday**. Each assignment is specifically chosen to review math concepts that have already been introduced and practiced in class. Students are expected to complete their homework and turn in it the next day. Homework is collected and will determine your student's Work and Study grade on the report card. I will accept late homework if it has been completed until the end of the week for partial credit. However, some points are better than no points. If the assignment is completed after the week it is assigned, the student may turn it in, but they will not receive any points as it is severely late.
