The Board of Trustees of Fort Wayne Community Schools met in special session April 7, 1959 at 6:15 P. M. Central Standard Time with President Willard Shambaugh in the chair and the following members present: Mrs. Marion M. Rastetter, Eugene Yergens, Gordon C. Reeves, M. R. Funari, Max G. Scott. Absent: Charles Slater.

↳ The Board first met as a Library Board and bids for a station wagon were received from the following companies:
