Registration Changes for 2015-16 School Year

1. Only a PARENT or GUARDIAN may register a student.
2. I.D. is REQUIRED for all parents or guardians
3. TWO proofs of residence for all students will be REQUIRED.
4. IF only one proof is available, please REGISTER for temporary enrollment--within 30 days, a second proof must be given to remain enrolled at Wayne.

Monday, July 27, 2015, Noon - 7 p.m.

Prior to Registration (For Schools)

- Inform families about registration details in the school newsletter and other communication sent home
- Use school signage to inform families about registration details

Requirements for Registration

- Only a parent/guardian can register a student for school
- *I.D. and two proofs of residence for address validation

Acceptable Proof of Residency (Any and all combinations are acceptable)

Proof of Home Ownership	Document from Gov't Agency
Court or Legal Papers	Rental Agreement (Must be typed)
Bank/Charge/Loan Statements	Payroll Stubs
Insurance bills	Utility bills
NO cable or cell phone bills	Medical bills

*All proofs of residency must be valid and within 30 days

*If a parent/guardian can only provide one proof of residency they will have 30 days to provide the 2nd proof. Schools are responsible for collecting the 2nd proof of residency within 30 days.
