Dear Parents,

Welcome back to a new school year! We've had a smooth start!

We send the Olympian newsletter home once a month. Watch for it in your child's book bag near the end of each month.

DISMISSAL REMINDERS – Please call the office (260-467-8820) **no later than 2:00 p.m.** with any changes to the way students would normally go home. We cannot take a student's word for it and must have either a note or phone call from a parent or guardian to make changes; otherwise, students will be sent home the normal way. All students going home **IN A CAR** must use the **CAR LINE**. Students are not allowed to walk to a car that is parked anywhere else. Walkers must be walking to their houses. See the map at the end of this newsletter with details about car line and walker dismissal. Thank you for helping us to keep all students, staff members, and families safe!

ATTENDANCE – According to the FWCS Code of Conduct, "It is the parent's responsibility to call the school by 9:00 a.m. the day a child is absent. If the parent does not call, the school will attempt to call the parent that day to document the absence. Notes from doctors, dentists, or other health care providers must be received by the attendance office within three days of the date the student returns to school. Notes not received within three days will not be accepted."

"If a total of five days of absence is reached anytime during the school year, a student must have a note from a medical doctor or any further absence will be counted as unexcused. However, a period of extended illness may be considered a single day for this requirement."

Also, if your child is going to be late, please call the office and let us know. This will save us from having to make calls to find out why your child is not at school.

Fort Wayne Community Schools educates all students to high standards, enabling them to become productive, responsible citizens.

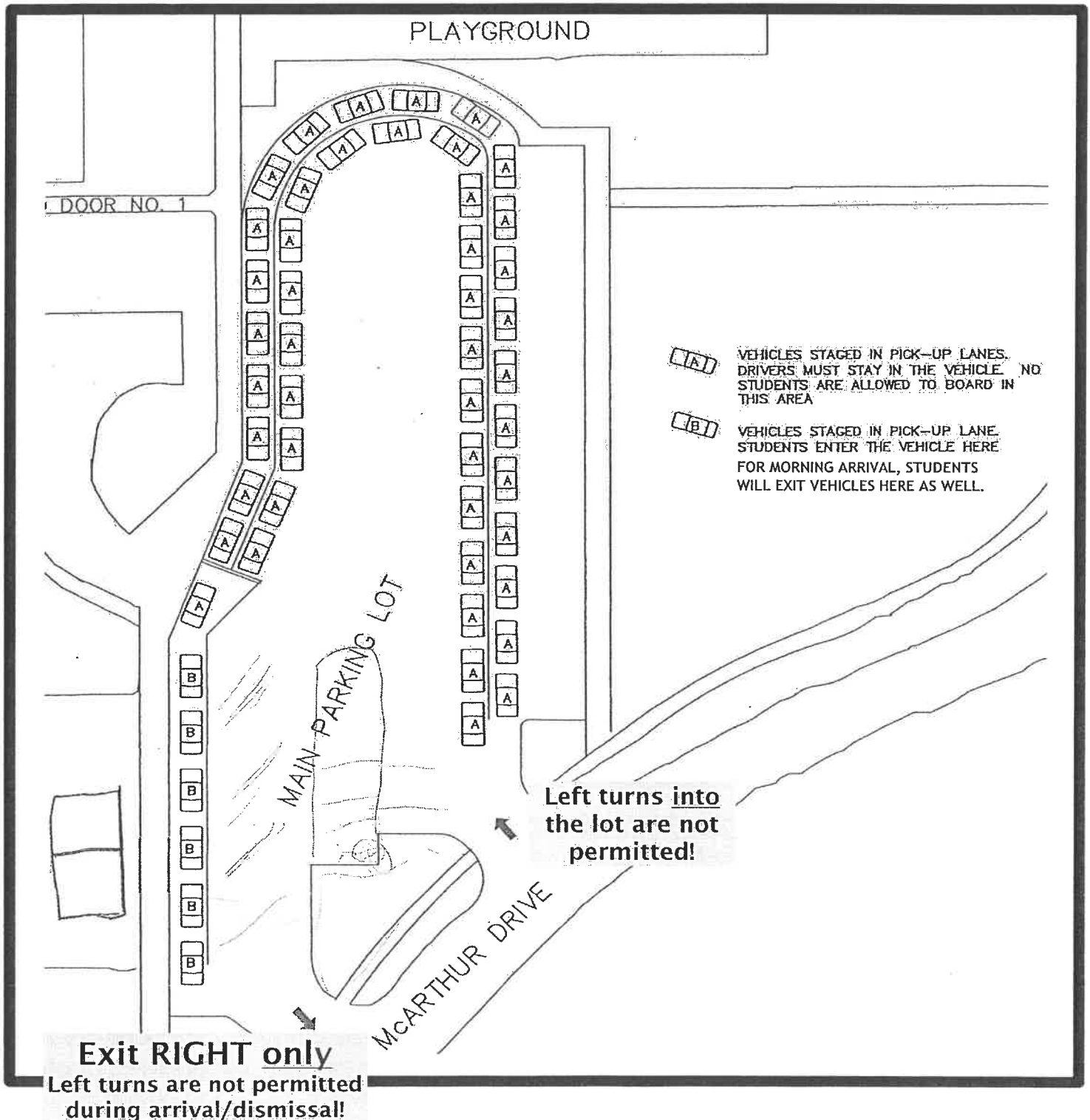
VISION

Drop-off/Pick-up procedures for Car-riders:

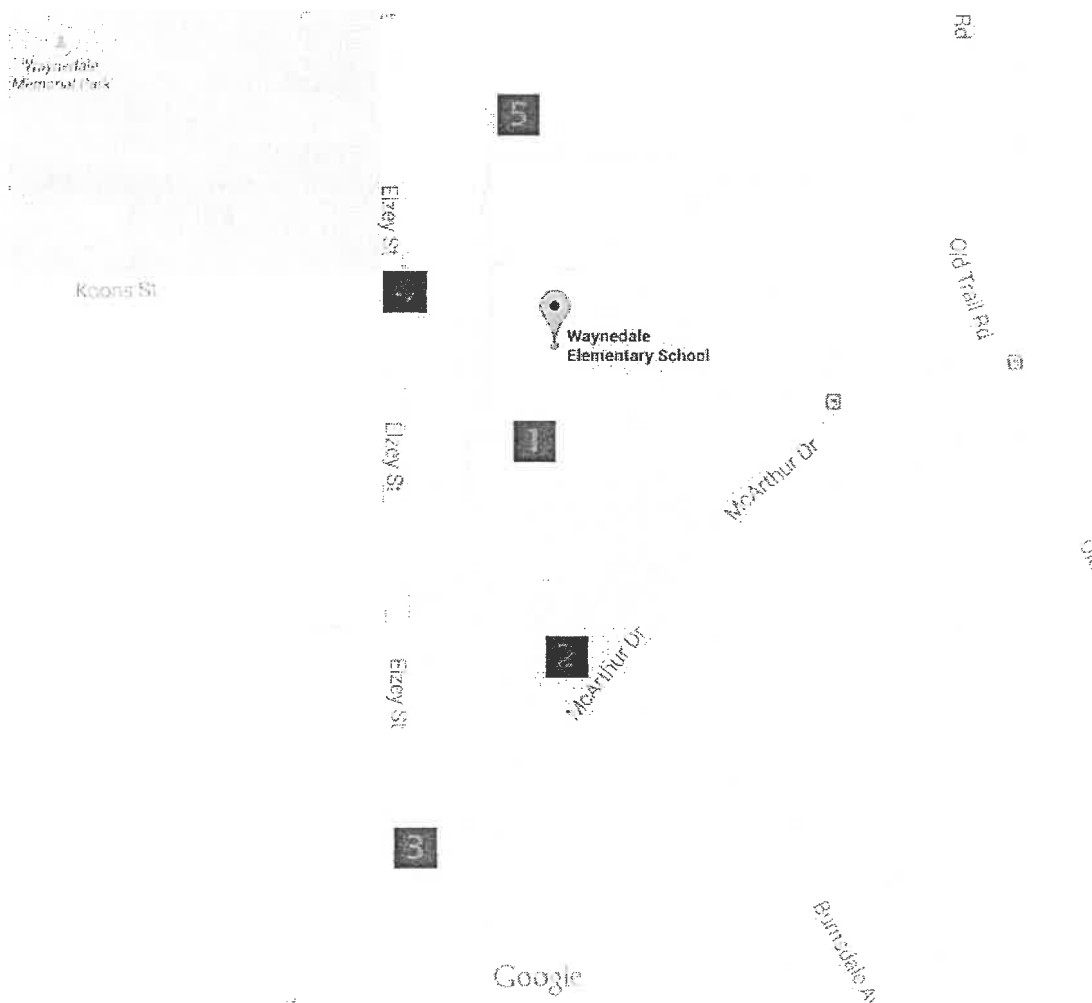
Cars will enter the East parking lot from McArthur Drive using two lanes. Traffic will merge into one lane as cars approach the fence by the Portable Classrooms. For drop-off, students are to leave their car and wait in their assigned grade-level box, marked on the pavement. At dismissal time, students will be dismissed to cars once their car has stopped in the single lane along the sidewalk (see map). **Cars should keep moving to the end of the line. When entering or exiting the parking lot, please turn only RIGHT, to prevent traffic backups!**

Walking traffic dismissal plan (times listed are approximate):


- 1** (2:57 p.m.) Mr. Cooper walks the walkers out door 3A on the South end of the building.
- 2** (2:58 p.m.) Mr. Cooper crosses students living South of school at the crosswalk on McArthur Drive, across from Burnsdale Avenue. The walker line continues around the corner on Elzey and McArthur.
- 3** (3:00 p.m.) Mr. Cooper crosses students living West of school on McArthur at the crosswalk on the corner of Elzey and McArthur.
- 4** (3:02 p.m.) Mr. Cooper crosses students living West of school at the crosswalk across from Waynedale Park. The walker line continues along Elzey, and Mr. Cooper supervises the students who live North on Elzey as they travel on the sidewalk.
- 5** (3:05 p.m.) Students who live East of school walk with Mr. Cooper on the sidewalk along the North side of the school and out to Old Trail Road.
