Project CHOICES is designed for rising 9th and 10th graders (and juniors on a case-by-case basis) who belong to minority or low-income populations or who are first-generation college students. The program aims to close the education attainment gap by providing:

- Hands-on/interactive activities related to career pathways.
- Engaging workshops related to test-taking tips, study-skills, and note-taking strategies in preparation for Knowledge Assessment, PSAT/SAT/ACT, and other standardized tests.
- Exposure to industry partners and apprenticeship career opportunities in high-demand fields.
- Orientation to the academic and student support resources available at Ivy Tech Community College Fort Wayne including K-14 Engagement and Transition, the Center for Academic Excellence, TRIO Support Services, and more.
- Introduction to faculty and students from Ivy Tech's many educational pathways.
