#### **Increase Academic Achievement**

#### **Student Support**

- Changed the student schedule from a 4X4 to a 7 period day
- Created a 9<sup>th</sup> Grade block with it's own counselor and administrator
- Restructured Guidance Counseling program
  - added one counselor to each high school
  - Realigned counseling duties (9<sup>th</sup> grade block, 10-12)
  - Realigned responsibilities of ECA coordinators
  - Added Navigation 101 college and career ready courses
- Added "Programs of Study" at each high school

#### **Student Support**

- Added online courses for credit recovery at all high schools, Ward, ACJC, and Anthis
- Realigned Youth Life Skills so that it is a direct support to high schools in increasing the graduation rate
- Increased dual credit and AP course offerings
- Added "advanced manufacturing" at North Side through Conexus Indiana and Ivy Tech
- Conducted class meetings setting expectations throughout the year
- Enhanced focus on attendance with attendance coordinators and others
- Implemented "Go Green" and standards tracking FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

#### **Teacher Support**

- Extended school day allowing for embedded professional learning
- Added Instructional Coaches
- Conducted teacher daily snapshots, focused feedbacks, held evaluation conferences providing support as needed
- Developed School Improvement Plans (SIP) through the work of the Quality Improvement Team (QIT)
